STAY PUT settled in hand off of the inside, responded when put to pressure with five-sixteenths to run, reeled in the leaders four wide, forged to command entering the stretch and steadily edged clear. VOW TO WAGER tracked the pace three deep, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the quarter pole, battled on between horses but was unable to match strides with the winner. KETTLE RIVER was caught in tight along the inside on the first turn, steadied losing ground, worked his way to the outside of BROKEN TANGO on the backstretch, assumed command on the second turn, disputed the issue to the stretch and weakened. ROCK HARD was unhurried into stride along the inside, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. BROKEN TANGO was away alertly to set the pace off of the inside, was headed nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way readily thereafter.

SPICER pulled to contention three deep, steadied between horses near the seven-sixteenths pole, shifted out for a clear path four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. RAPHAEL ALEXANDRO tucked in to save ground leaving the chute and was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch, finished well but was left with too much to do. BOLD VICTORY attended the pace along the inside, worked his way out and between horses into the stretch, dropped back to the rail for the drive but weakened in the final furlong. L. C. SHERYL'S MELODY tracked the pace three wide under rating, moved to challenge leaving the three furlong marker, took command nearing the lane, kicked clear under left handed urging nearing the furlong marker and was kept to solid hand urging through the final seventy yards. POPLAR GIRL, taken to rate three wide, made steady progress four wide to loomed boldly into lane, chased the winner home in willing fashion and was clearly second best. C. S. ROYCE stalked the pace while saving ground, swung out leaving the far turn, circled five wide under a ride, mustered up a mild late response and just got up for the show. KATHERN'S KITTEN leaned in at the break and steadied back a bit, lagged for six furlongs, came three wide for the drive, angled in nearing the furlong marker and finished with interest. CIRCLEBOUND BAY stalked the pace between rivals, was put to the whip nearing the half mile pole, chased the leaders leaving the five sixteenths pole and failed to generate the needed kick. HYMN BOOK made a long drive four wide, forged a narrow lead with five-sixteenths to run, was unable to match strides with the winner through the upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong but had enough left to hold the show. SILVER MOUNTAIN was taken in hand at once and settled into stride at the tail of the field, moved up four wide when called upon nearing the three-eighths pole, was carried out further entering the stretch when ROGUE VICTORY came out and failed to sustain the advance. SOUTHERN EXCHANGE was rank to place along the inside, checked entering the first turn, altered course to the outside and pulled to the lead three wide before going a half, disputed the issue for six furlongs but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. ANARKO (CHI) rushed to the lead and angled in to set the pressured pace, was headed near the five-sixteenths pole and gave way readily thereafter.
