KURBAT (CHI) chased the pace outside RASCAL CAT, bid for the lead midway on the far turn, lightly bumped with NO MESA WITH ME in upper stretch, dueled with the winner in the drive and finished gamely. NO MESA WITH ME, three wide both turns, chased the pace, bid for the lead between the top pair near the five sixteenths pole then weakened after being jostled between those rivals near the three sixteenths pole. REHOBOTH lacked speed, raced along the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. BANK OF DAD saved ground and was outrun. DISTRIBUTOR, wide entering the stretch, was not a factor. RASCAL CAT set the pace along the rail and faltered leaving the far turn. Objections by the rider of NO MESA WITH ME against PRIMARY WITNESS and KURBAT for alleged interference in upper stretch were not allowed.

VIRSITO cleared early, set a rated pace towards the inside, was joined by MIKOSHI in upper stretch, dueled, lost the lead in mid stretch, battled back under solid left handed urging and regained command in the final fifty yards. MIKOSHI settled in mid pack while off the rail, angled out four wide into the far turn, rallied four deep nearing the quarter pole, collared the winner in upper stretch, dueled, took a slim lead a furlong out, continued willingly but was outfinished late. CREW, taken to rate, was steadied off the heels of MIKOSHI nearing the far turn, advanced between rivals mid way on the final turn, angled out four wide for the drive and closed willingly. CLASS BOPPER was steadied along the rail under the wire the first time, steadied again leaving the five eighths pole, stalked the pace while saving ground leaving the far turn then came up empty in the final furlong. NEW BELIEVER was rated back soon after the break, settled off the rail, advanced between rivals leaving the furlong marker and finished with interest. LUCKMAN, wide down the backstretch, was forced out some around the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch and flattened out. NOAH'S DREAM saved ground and lacked a rally. NIGHTSCAPE stalked the pace three wide, moved a bit closer between rivals nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the final furlong. OVECHKIN was outrun. TWISTED DREAM stalked the winner while two wide and faltered after six furlongs. An objection by the rider of CREW against MIKOSHI for alleged interference around the far turn was not allowed

MIDNITE COMMUNION, four wide past the five eighths pole while within range, dropped to the inside leaving the three eighths pole, advanced along the rail nearing the lane, shifted out nearing the eighth pole and chased the winner home in game fashion. MONEY FOR LOVE settled back early, saved ground into the lane and finished willingly. QUANTICO HERO was angled out past the wire the first time and moved up outside the winner to challenge, prompted that one to the head of the lane then faded. NO BRAKES lagged back, was put to a ride nearing the far turn, circled five to six wide into the lane and lacked a solid run. THUNDER CHARM lacked speed, saved ground into the lane, eased out near the three sixteenths marker but failed to generate the needed response.
